# PLANNING YOUR EVENT

Decisions, decisions! There are many ways to make your event special and fun for everyone. But not every activity works for every group. Here are a few things to think about before you start your announcements.

## Snacks?

Some venues are open to having food, while others have restrictions. Make sure you're aware of any rules before you plan on having food. If you are able to offer treats, be sure to have a visible list of all ingredients and avoid foods with allergens such as peanuts. Consider serving Judy Moody's and Stink's favorite ice-cream flavors: Rain Forest Mist and Chocolate Mud! You'll need bowls, napkins, spoons, and an adult volunteer to scoop. Or what about mini cupcakes with rainbow sprinkles? Find fun cupcake toppers in this kit!



## Look-alike contest!

Invite kids to come dressed as their favorite illustration of Judy Moody or Stink. You can have a parade or fashion show. You may want to have some extra feather boas, bandages, and other accessories on hand for kids who don't come in costume. Plan any judging or prizes in advance as well. If you have a local celebrity or town official attend your event, he or she can act as a judge.

## Book Sale!

Kids will love to go home with a book. If you are a librarian or teacher, contact your local bookseller to see if they'd like to sell books during your event. Place your order for Judy Moody and Stink books six weeks prior to your event. You'll find a book list at the end of this kit.






# PROMOTING YOUR EVENT

- Get other groups involved. Local teachers, librarians, community centers, youth groups, scouting organizations, and businesses may be interested in joining with you to help kids get excited about books. Local merchants may want to contribute coupons or prizes!
- Get the word out. Contact your local newspaper, parent-teacher organizations, local parenting bloggers, and regional social networking groups so they can include your event in their listings. Look at your local PBS and NPR stations' websites, as many have post-it-yourself online event calendars.
- If you're hosting a look-alike contest, be sure to highlight that in all of your materials so that kids know to come in costume.
- Contact your elected officials so that they know about your Judy Moody Day event. Invite your mayor or other town officials to stop by!
- Send an event announcement to your e-newsletter subscribers or patron list.
- Post flyers (two sizes are included in this kit) in your local library branches, school offices, and bookstores, and leave a stack of the smaller flyers for people to take with them. Small flyers work great as bookstore bag stuffers or library checkout desk book stuffers.
- Make sure to update your website, Facebook page, or PTO listserv with event information.
- Six weeks before your event, start spreading the word via your social media channels. Increase your posts and tweets as your event date nears. Find suggestions for social media messaging on the next page!



# MAKE A MOOD RING




Read about Judy's mood ring in *Judy Moody Predicts the Future*. When the mystery prize in a box of cereal is a mood ring, Judy closes her eyes and imagines it turning purple, for "Joyful, On Top of the World" —but maybe the mood ring knows Judy's mood better than she does! Now you can make your own mood ring to perfectly match your mood.

## You'll need:

- An assortment of various colored buttons
- Pipe cleaners or elastic
- Beads (optional)
- Scissors
- A helpful adult

## To do:

1. Pick a button that matches your mood. Refer to Judy's Mood Ring Guide for each color's significance. (See lower left corner.)
2. With a pipe cleaner for younger children, or elastic for older ones, thread the button by pushing up from the bottom of one button hole and back down through another hole.
3. Optional: To make the ring fancier, you can string beads on either side of the button.
4. Placing the button on the top of your finger, have a friend or adult tie the elastic or twist the pipe cleaner to fit the ring to your finger. Remember to make the ring big enough to slide on and off your finger!
5. Cut off any excess pipe cleaner or elastic. Bend the sharp ends of the pipe cleaner so they won't scratch.

# CREATE A ME COLLAGE

When Judy Moody's teacher, Mr. Todd, assigns a project he calls a Me collage, Judy thinks it sounds fun (although she doesn't say so). Mr. Todd tells his students to make a collage that is "all about YOU." He says to "draw or cut out pictures or paste things to your collage that tell the class what makes you YOU." Think about what makes you YOU. Then start gathering materials to create your own Me collage. Use ideas from Mr. Todd's list below — and any other categories you can think of! Paste your collage to a big piece of poster board.

# TREASURE HUNT

You'll need scissors, markers, envelopes, a bandage, a plush or plastic toad, a pencil, a mood ring, and a plush or plastic cat.


## Before the event:

- Reproduce the following sheet several times so that you'll have one set of clues for each team. Cut out each picture, then cut up each picture into several pieces. You can determine how hard or easy the treasure hunt will be by making the pieces large or small accordingly.
- Place the pieces for each picture into its own envelope, then bundle the envelopes so that there is a complete set of all the pictures for each team. Mark each envelope with a color or name so that it's clear which team each envelope belongs to.
- Hide the following objects around the event space: a bandage, a plush or plastic toad, a mood ring, a "Grouchy pencil" (take an ordinary yellow pencil and draw a mad face on it in permanent marker), and a plush or plastic cat.
- Next to each hidden object, place an envelope for each team that contains the next clue. Be sure that there is one (and only one) envelope for each team at the site of any given clue.
- If you're expecting young kids or a big crowd, you can separate the space into different zones (one zone for each clue) to make the treasure hunt easier and to help with traffic flow.

## At the event:

- Divide kids into groups to create four or five teams, or arrange the activity at a station so that only four or five kids are doing the treasure hunt at a time.
- Give each team one envelope (it's best to give each team a different picture to start with). Teams must put the pieces together to determine what they're looking for. After they find the object, they'll pick up the next clue.
- When a team finishes the treasure hunt, you may want to give them a prize. One idea is to make extra copies of the "Congratulations" card on page 19 so that you can hand one to each child as a certificate of completion.


# Host a Right Royal Tea Party!

Judy is related to a ROYAL! No lie!





Share Judy's love of all things British and royal with a fun tea party event!

- Decorate your event space with British flags and Union Jack accessories.
- Read the first chapter of *Judy Moody and the Right Royal Tea Party* aloud to your party guests.
- Serve tea, of course, from a proper teapot, if possible. Look for mismatched teacups at area thrift stores. Serve kid-friendly finger sandwiches made from white bread with the crusts removed. Add jelly between the bread slices and cut them into triangles. Offer biscuits (Brit-speak for cookies) for dessert.
- Tell some royal jokes: When is a piece of wood like a queen? When it's a ruler! What did the paste-eater say to the queen? Stick with me!
- Play "What's in the Queen's Purse?" Fill a large handbag with things Queen Elizabeth II carries in her royal purse: mints, hankies/tissues, reading glasses, dog treats for her corgis, a crossword puzzle, a penknife, a lipstick, a mirror, and good-luck charms. Invite your guests to guess what's in the purse. As they guess correctly, pull the items from the handbag.





- If you can find a well-mannered corgi among your friends and acquaintances, invite the pooch to your event and allow the owner to introduce the queen's favorite breed to your guests. If you can't find a real corgi, show pictures of corgis from a book or play a video.
- Use "Judy Moody's Know-Your-Onions Guide to British Sayings" at the back of *Judy Moody and the Right Royal Tea Party* to quiz your guests on British lingo.
- Invite your guests to decorate crowns and dub everyone royal with fancy titles: Royal Giggler, Royal Reader, Royal Book Carrier, Royal Cartwheeler, etc. To make the crowns, photocopy the following page onto card stock. Cut the paper in half along the zigzag line. Invite your guests to color their crowns with markers, crayons, or colored pencils and decorate them with glitter and press-on jewels. Tape the short ends together to make a circular crown. Have a royal parade!
